Criteria For Testing (As per ICMR dated 09/04/2020)
Indications for RT-PCR (Throat swab + Nasal Swab)

1. All asymptomatic individuals who have undertaken international travel in the last 14 days
2. All **primary contacts** (direct and high-risk contacts) of Confirmed cases
 - a. If asymptomatic - test immediately
 - b. If Asymptomatic - should be tested once between day 7 and day 14 of coming in to his/her contact
3. All **asymptomatic health-care workers**
4. All hospitalized patients with **Severe Acute Respiratory Illness** (fever AND cough and/or absence of breath)
5. Asymptomatic direct & high-risk contacts of a confirmed case should be tested once between Day 7 and Day 14 of coming in his/her contact
6. Hot spots/Clusters (as per SHIFW) and in large migration gatherings or mass centers
7. All symptomatic **Influenza Like Illness** patients (Fever, cough, sore throat, runny nose)
 - a. Within 7 days of illness - RT PCR
 - b. After 7 days of illness - Antibody test (if negative, confirmed by RT PCR)

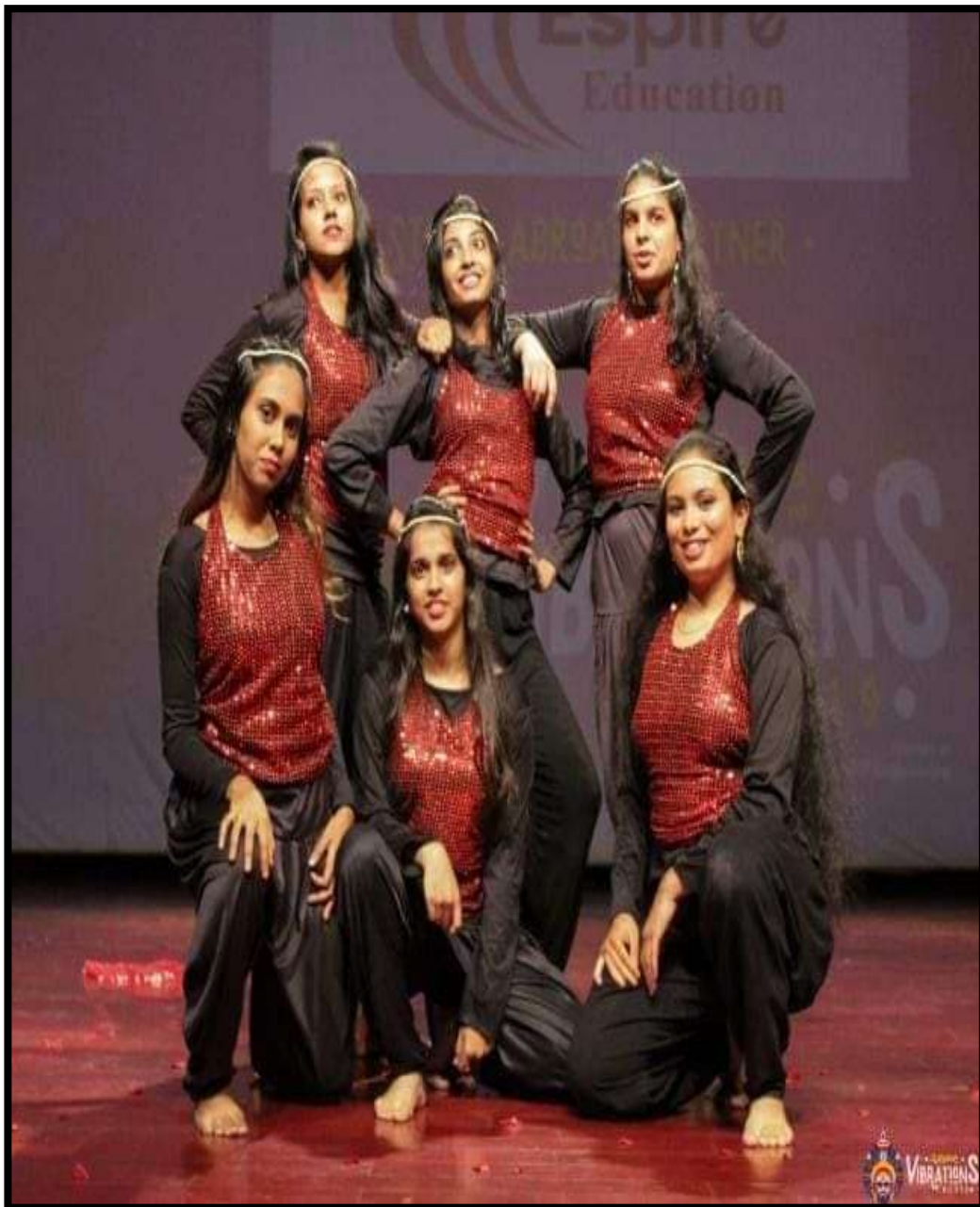
