

### **CDSIMER HEALTH EDUCATION & OUTREACH PROGRAMME 2021**



### Day 2: Dodda Alahalli PHC and nearby villages - 06/01/2021



Day 3: Dodda Alahalli PHC, Kodihalli PHC and nearby villages – 07/01/2021








Day 5: Kodihalli and nearby villages - 09/01/2021







The first session consisted all the basic information and statistics of tobacco production, forms and its usage in India and around the world. The existing rules and guidelines for its production and sales were also mentioned.




