Response: Social commitment towards our neighbourhood community is always been vision and mission of our institution. We always aim at instilling social values and moral responsibility within the students. Community outreach programs and camps were conducted within our state and the nearby neighbouring states also. Regular visits to Old age homes and orphanages are organized. This kind of holistic approach and community outreach programs and initiatives help our students grow as socially responsible citizens.

Our UG and PG students actively participated in covid - 19 vaccination drive programs and they also worked as volunteers in many covid isolation centres on rotation. Many students and even the faculty members voluntarily participated in Tele - consultation program by Step one which helped a lot for the home quarantined covid patients.

AIDS awareness campaigns are conducted and HEPATITIS awareness Walkathon was done. Blood donation camps are conducted on a regular basis.

Tobacco awareness and cessation programs are organized regularly. We do have a tobacco cessation cell within the college which help the patients in quitting tobacco habits.

These kind of activities have helped our students to get more sensitized to social issues in the early years of their careers

All the faculty and students are thoroughly trained in biomedical waste disposal with in the campus and at extended community outreach programs also.

Seminars were conducted for Group D workers during covid time and free kits, medication were distributed. They were educated regarding hygiene maintenance.

Our faculty were appointed in NSS advisory committee of RGUHS.

Swachh Bharath Abhiyaan: It is aligned with clean campus initiative. Programs are conducted to work towards making plastic free zone. Entire patient record system and OP system has been digitalised to work towards as paperless as possible.

We are working towards becoming sustainable campus by recycling water.

Public health department is tied up with various satellite clinic in collaboration with the state government PHC to provide service for the general public.

A short video about Thalassemia Major patients and their requirement for blood was played to instill the idea of blood donation among the students. There were more than **120 enthusiastic volunteers** who registered for blood donation and we were successfully able to collect **72 pints of blood** from the enthusiastic volunteers. Refreshments and participation certificate were provided to all the donors.

CDSIMER HEALTH EDUCATION & OUTREACH PROGRAMME 2021

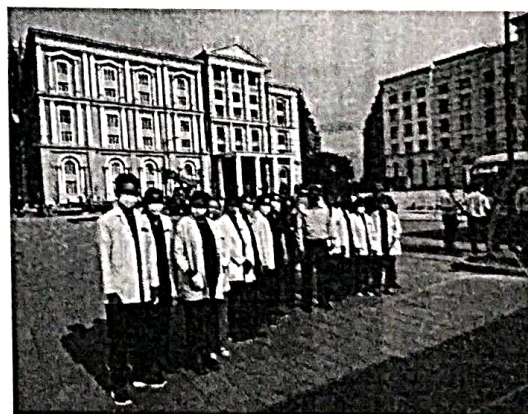

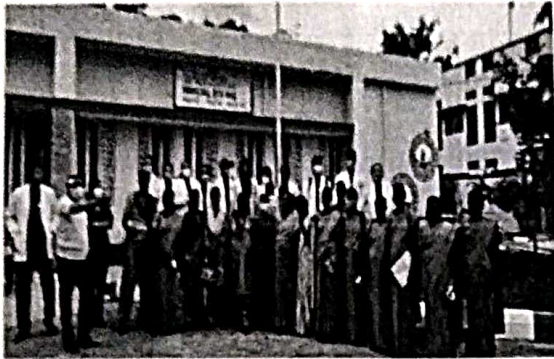

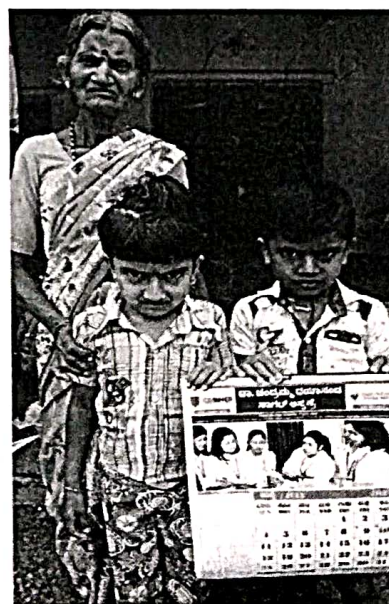
Day 4 : Dodda Alahalli PHC and Maralabekuppe – 08/01/2021

The scarce information on dental health awareness, attitude, oral health-related habits and behavior among the low income population prompted us to make them aware of the oral hygiene practices. 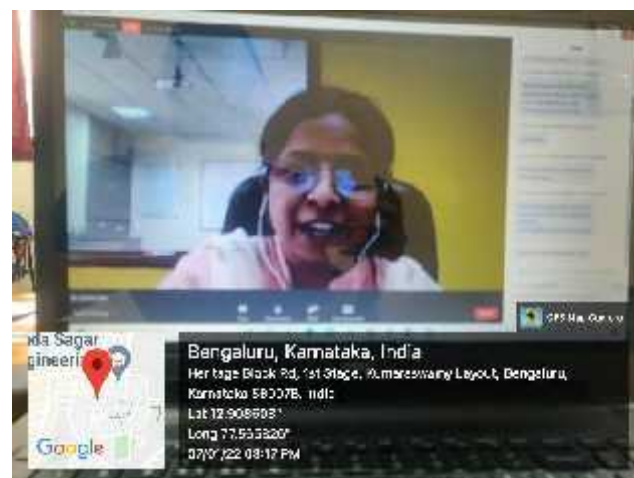

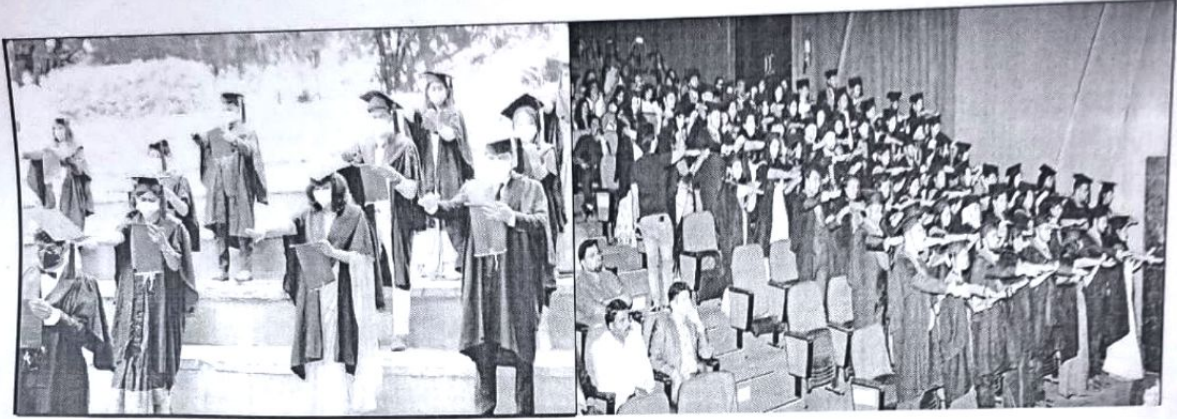



Report on World No Tobacco Day Webinar
5th June 2021

Dayananda Sagar College of Dental Sciences Bangalore, Department of Public Health Dentistry in association with NSS RGUHS conducted a Webinar on the topic Holistic approach to Tobacco Cessation to commemorate the World No Tobacco Day which is celebrated on the 31st of May every year. The theme for this year is----“**COMMIT TO QUIT**”. The Webinar was based on this theme and we invited distinguished speakers in the field of tobacco cessation **Dr Vikrant Mohanthy, Dr Ashwini and Ms. Shinon** from Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences, Delhi.

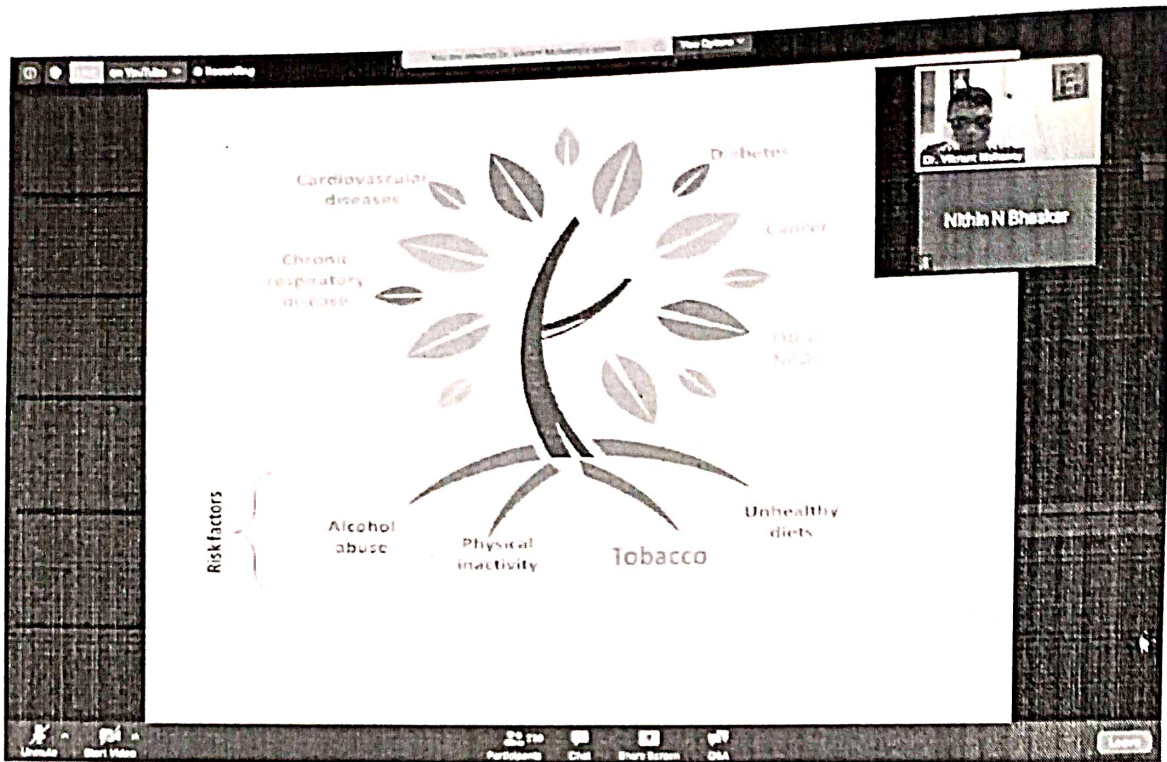
The program was planned in 4 sessions including **role-play** where a team of Psychologists and psychotherapists enacted a patient and doctor conversation and the various strategies that could be adopted to help the patient in tobacco cessation. **The first session** consisted all the basic information and statistics of tobacco production, forms and its usage in India and around the world. The existing rules and guidelines for its production and sales were also mentioned.

The second session focused around dentist as the main resource person and an important stake holder of Tobacco cessation and how tobacco cessation cells in colleges could be utilized in helping students quit the habit as well as plan and strategize a holistic method for cessation. Various **Nicotine replacement therapies** were discussed in detail. The speakers covered various topics of tobacco cessation and the **role of dentists, family, peers and society** in quitting the habit. The last session of the program covered **research lacunae** where many areas of Research evidence was low or moderate was highlighted and these could open up new venues for research for our post graduate students.

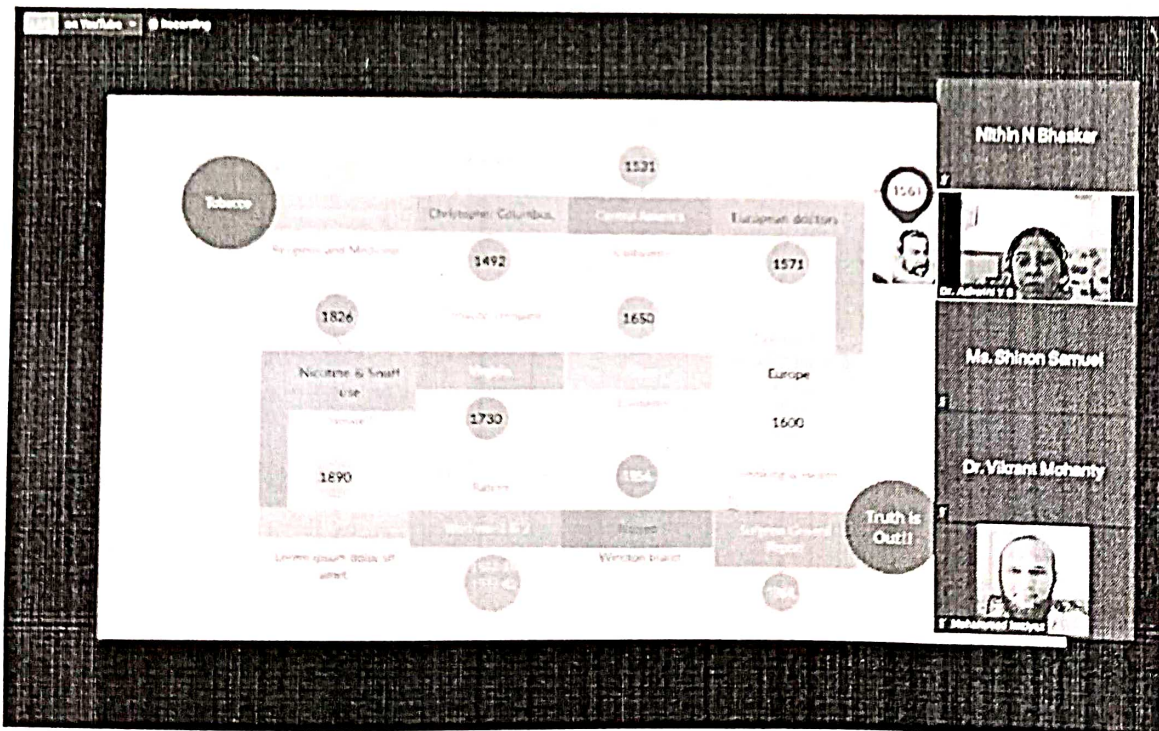
