

Dr Nagesh L, the chief resource person for the workshop, along with Dr Ravi Shirahatti and Dr Shyam Sivasamy (speakers), are faculty in the discipline of Public Health Dentistry and have been conducting, workshops on Research Methodology, Biostatistics, Critical Evaluation of Scientific Articles, Research Ethics, Scientific Writing and other allied topics for many years. They have conducted workshops on above said subjects in medical colleges and dental colleges across the country.

The inaugural function took place on 28<sup>th</sup> August, 2018 at 11:45 AM, and the occasion was graced by Shri Galiswamy, Secretary, DSI, Dr. Hemanth M, Principal, DSCDS and Dr. Roopa R Nadig, Dean, DSCDS.

They were also able to calculate sample size for a given research using G power soft ware and enter the dummy data into the excel sheet, import, analyze the data using SPSS and interpret the data.

At the end of the CDE Programme we received very good feedback for organizing such a programme. Most of them were happy to have gained more knowledge and take home messages. Each and every one of the delegates went home with eager minds to pen down their research works and to do further research with the skills that they had acquired in these 4 days.

The programme was a huge success, and this is a remarkable achievement for the Department of Public Health Dentistry, DSCDS, and for the DSI as a whole.



The proposal for this program was first suggested in a staff meeting, in the department of Public Health Dentistry. Our intention was to conduct a research program which would be a continuation of our first workshop on Health Research Methodology and Health Statistics. The workshop was designed to help every participant to apply the knowledge of basics of Health research and Health statistics into application through group activities. The idea was to practice the principle of 'Learning by Doing'. This can also drive the concepts of research methodology and biostatistics deep into the realm of 'Known' in the delegates.

The registration for the research program was first opened up to the faculty and PG students of our college, till 18<sup>th</sup> Jan 2019. registrations once we reached 80 participants. Karnataka State Dental Council has awarded 12 CDE points for the workshop. The registration fee for the workshop was Rs. 900/-.

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












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## **COMPREHENSIVE LASER WORKSHOP (2018)**

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




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#### **ORAL HYGIENE DAY 2017**


## "Rotary Endodontics and Hands-on workshop"

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

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

The didactic part of the surgical module (second module)was conducted at the Dept. of Oral Surgery from 28<sup>th</sup>March till 29<sup>th</sup> March2019. The lectures were covered by our staff prior to the hands-on workshop as a 2 - full day program.

This time, we had developed a protocol, where the delegates had to give an exam before taking up the 2<sup>nd</sup> module. This time we collected feedback in an e-format for the lectures & the workshop conducted.

The study material for all the lectures of Modules 1 & 2 were mailed to all the delegates well in advance to facilitate learning &in a process of providing study material to the participants.

The surgical hands-on module was conducted from 8th -10<sup>th</sup> April 2019, which gave a wonderful hands-on training to all the delegates by making them place implants on dummy mandibles as well as on patients. This module was a coordinated effort of four departments: Departments of Oral Medicine and Radiology, Oral Surgery, Periodontics and Prosthodontics conducted with the help of renowned external resource persons Dr Vinayak Gowda and Dr.Deepak. The programme was inaugurated by the Chief Guest, Dr. A.N.N Murthy, honourable Vice Chancellor of DSU and our beloved Secretary Shri Galiswamy as guest of honour. Dr ANN Murthy has helped by signing an MOU for a collaborative project with Aerospace Engineering, DSU.

In 3 days we placed 20 implants as compared to placement of only 30 implants in 5 whole years between 2013 to 2018. All 3 days, cases done by delegates were guided by the resource persons by personally being present in the Minor-OT giving inputs for the implant placement & helping them with each step right from case of the surgical procedure.

Some interesting & challenging cases were chosen for live demonstration by the resource persons Dr Vinayak Gowda and Dr Deepak Shiva who efficiently demonstrated their skills with detailed explanation of each step. The department of Oral Surgery has now been equipped with a TV & facility to project live, the proceedings from the Minor-OT, which was utilized well for the 2-way interaction between the resource persons & the delegates. It was a unique & memorable experience for the delegates at DSCDS, which all of them enjoyed

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thoroughly, where many questions raised by the delegates were clarified by the resource persons.

The responses for the training were extremely satisfactory and encouraging. Overall, the delegates enjoyed and liked the hands-on training and appreciated the enthusiasm, motivation, patience and cooperation of the resource persons during the conduction of the workshop. They appreciated & acknowledged the fact of demonstrating unique cases, which they usually don't find in regular textbooks.

The implants placed in this module will be restored in a 2-day program of 3<sup>rd</sup> module where the implants will be restored with crowns facilitating proper function and esthetics.

The workshop ended on 10<sup>th</sup> April with a panel discussion, valedictory & a photo session.





## 4. Rally and Health Awareness program near BMCRI, Chamrajpet




AHA certified BLS instructor Dr. Sham Sundar from JSS Dental College, Mysore was the trainer for the workshop.


