Guidelines for registered participants:

Dress Code -

Men: White full-sleeve shirts with dark-coloured trousers, preferably blue, grey, or black, matching socks, and polished black shoes, belts, and ties. Coming dressed in a full suit is strongly recommended.

Women: Sarees of an individual's & choice with appropriate footwear.

Overall dress sense: This should conform to the needs of the solemn occasion. The internal and external response should reflect the mood, dignity, maturity, and ambiance of the event, which all of you possess. As a grown-up citizen, you now demonstrate a new culture and feeling while walking out of the campus as a proud DSIan, having crossed a critical milestone.

Registration

Please come to the campus at 2:00 PM for registration and a rehearsal on the appointed day. Register your name at the main entrance. Please confirm your participation and if your parents will join you at the event and dinner by 4:00 PM on 26 th October 2023. You are to send the information about the registration to your respective HODs/ Principals.

Graduation March:

Participation is mandatory. Participants would be assigned a number for reference, which needs to be used until the close of the event.

Seating:

You will occupy the designated seats in two specially erected grandstands on either side of the football ground for engineering and all other programmes. The grandstand will ensure the appropriate seating. You would be allowed to go on stage to receive the gold/silver medals if you are a university rank holder, a College/Department Topper, and certificates for completing the academic program.



The sequence of events on the day of the event: 29th October 2023

02.00 PM

Registration will be open at the respective college/department registration counters at the main entrance; receive graduation dress: gowns and caps. Photography with your graduation dress would be possible in as many groups, but all of which should be over by 2:30 PM.

02.30 PM

Assemble at the designated place for the graduation march: A student volunteer holding a placard indicating the respective branch for easy identification will lead each unit. You must be part of that group and march in a column and a row of threes. HoDs and faculty of respective departments will stay close to the graduating batches to ensure the orderly flow of the event.

03.00 PM

Graduation March: The Graduation March for Engineering will start at the Conveno and move out of the campus via **Gate Two** beside the Bank of Baroda and again enter **Gate One** of the campus, walking through as the Army Band leads the college department units to reach the Football Grounds. All other programmes under BU and RGUHS will start at the ICSE School/DSBS with the military band in the lead and enter the football ground. The guests, accompanied by the Chairman / Vice Chairman and other dignitaries, will lead the Graduation March from the Board Room, garlanding the Founder's statue and leading the march from the Central Library.
