Dental wax carving exercises are a practical component designed to teach tooth morphology and develop the psychomotor skills necessary for clinical dentistry. This exercise is an essential part of the preclinical dental curriculum, helping students integrate cognitive and psychomotor skills with a solid understanding of tooth morphology. This foundation is crucial for diagnosing and managing dental disorders related to tooth development, such as taurodontism, dens in dente, peg laterals, gemination, fusion, supernumerary roots, or mispositioning. Students are assigned seminar topics to deepen their understanding of these issues. They are also encouraged to participate in UG conferences, presenting papers and posters to engage with current research in the field. Additionally, in collaboration with the Oral Pathology Society, the department organizes camps to raise awareness about oral cancer, offering students practical exposure alongside theoretical knowledge.






