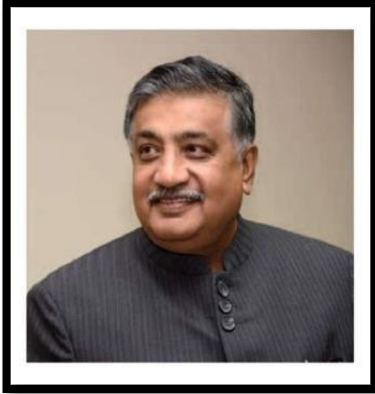

To develop thorough knowledge, skills, and attitudes required to meet the above objective.

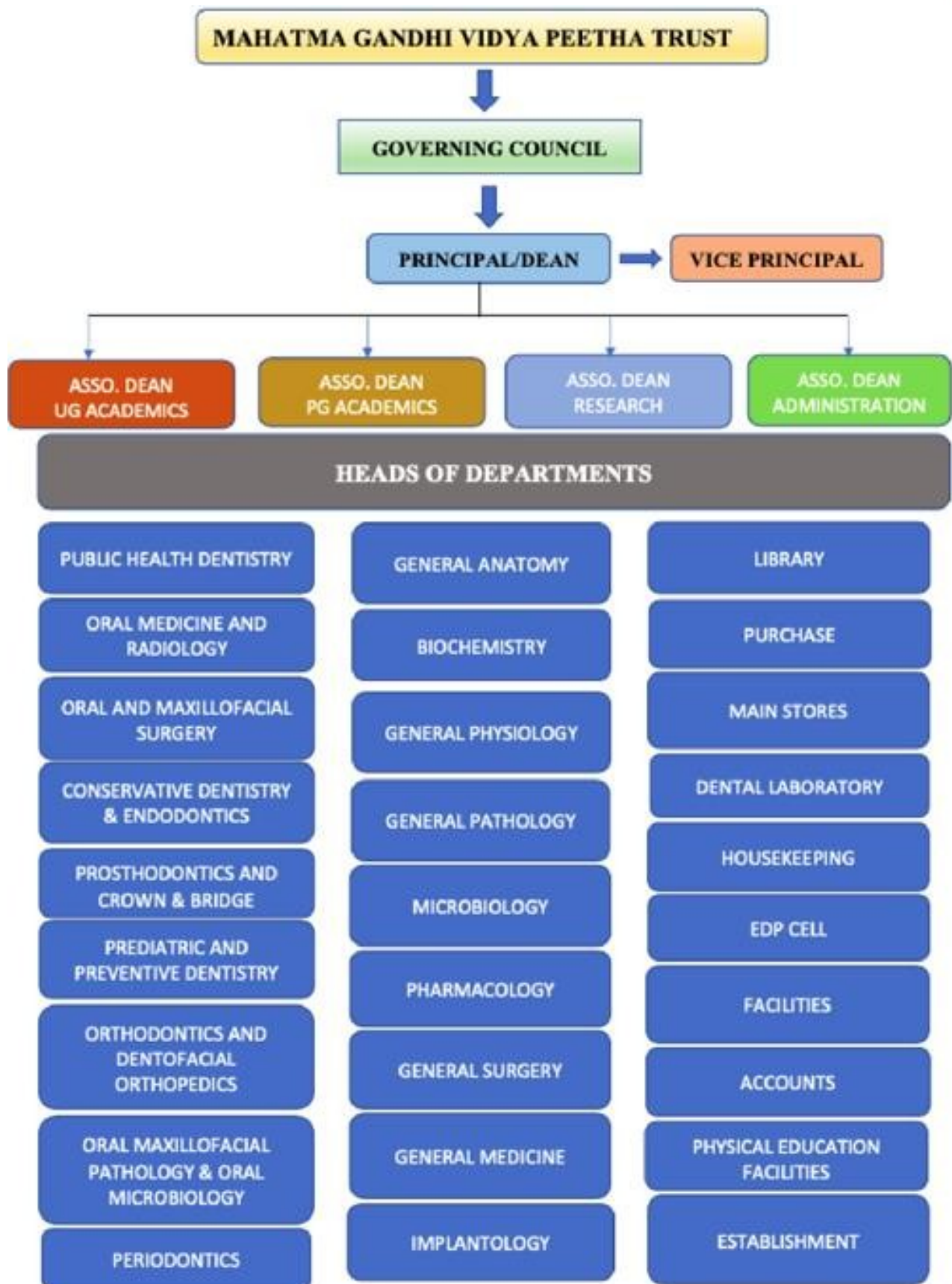
To inculcate necessary clinical, diagnostic, and treatment skills to manage patients at a clinical level and to extend similar quality services at a community level.

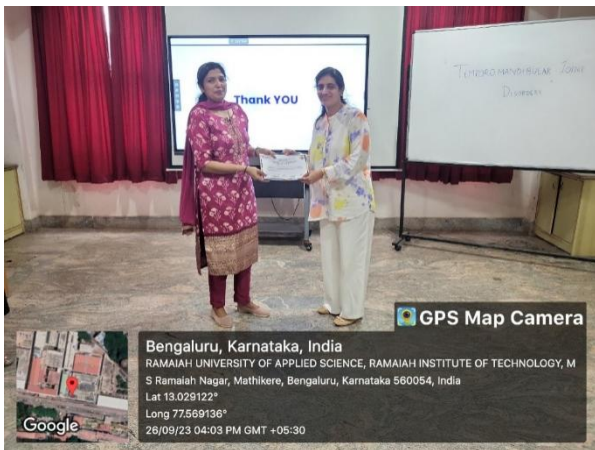

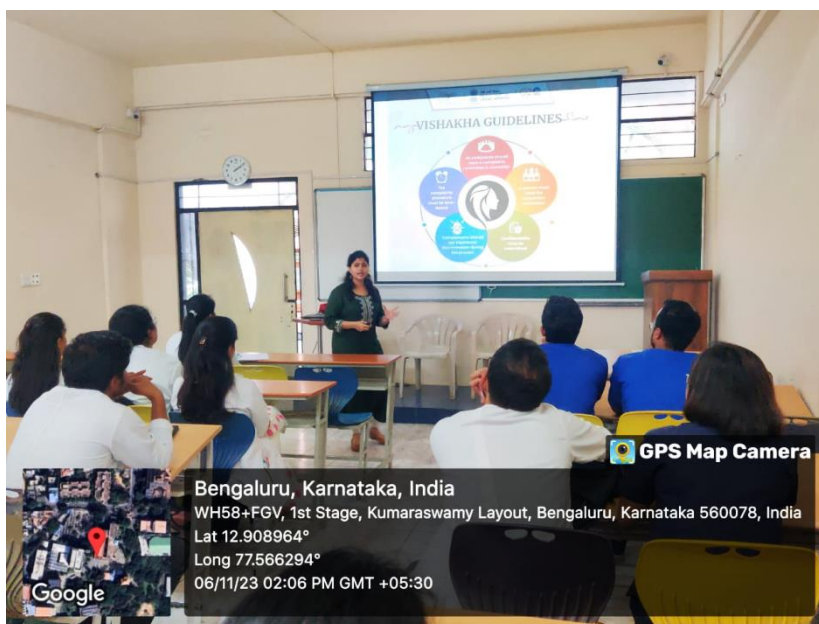

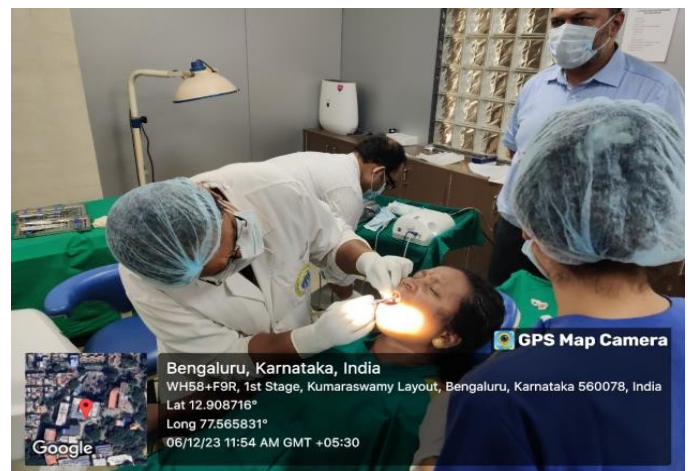
TALK ON 'GENDER SENSITIZATION' DURING PG ORIENTATION PROGRAM

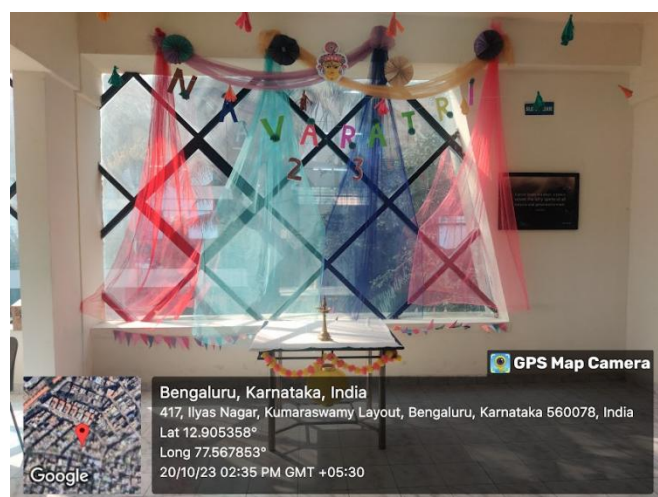
GRADUATION DAY on 9-10-2023

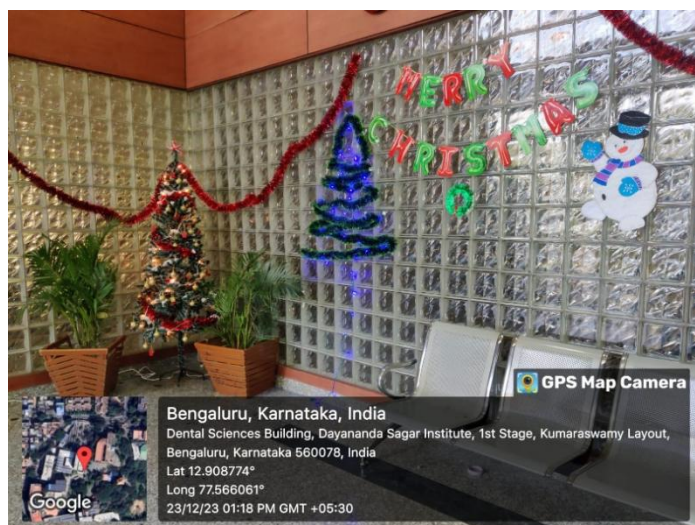
DIWALI CELEBRATIONS on 11-11-2023

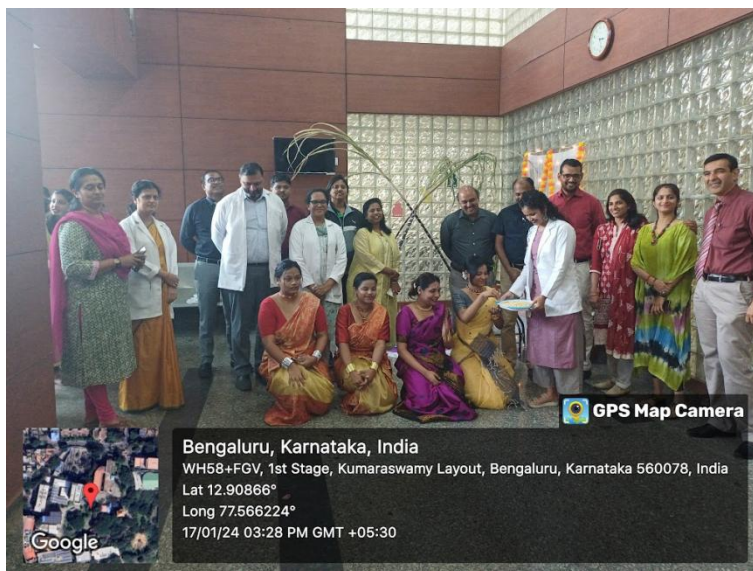

We Won against KGF Dental College Kolar, M S Ramaiah Dental College and KLE Dental College. Lost against BIDS in Quarter Finals.



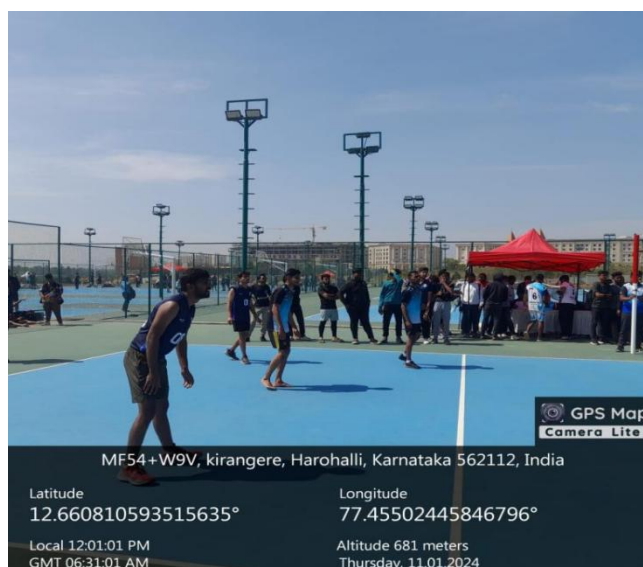
