#### SUMMARY OF THE FEEDBACK

## 1.1 Student feedback on the curriculum

86.1% felt that the course objectives were clear 9.7% somewhat agreed and 4.2% remained neutral.

77.8% of them said the content was completed at the end of the term 18.1% somewhat agreed and 4.21% remained neutral.

94.4% felt they were encouraged to actively participate in the teaching learning process and 5.6% students didn't find it encouraging.

97.2% felt that learning was supported by theory /practical classes adequately.

88.9% of the students felt that the learning resources in the library were adequate 9.7% somewhat agreed and 1.4% remained neutral.

88.9% of the students felt curriculum was effective in developing innovative thinking 9.7% somewhat agreed and 1.41% remained neutral.

95.8% of the students felt that interest was stimulated by the course and content.

91.7% felt that assessments methods used for practical classes were adequate.

90.3% felt that assessments methods used for theory classes were adequate 8.3% somewhat agreed and 1.4% remained neutral.

#### 1.2 Faculty feedback on curriculum

88.9% of the faculty felt that the content addressed the objectives of learning in their respective speciality 9.3% somewhat agreed and 1.9% remained neutral.

85.2% felt the curriculum addresses the training need for the student in dental education 11.1% somewhat agreed and 3.7% remained neutral.

87% felt there is flexibility for innovation and newer ideas 7.4% somewhat agreed and 5.6% remained neutral.

87% felt curriculum involves technology and recent advances 9.3% somewhat agreed and 3.7% remained neutral.

86.9% felt institutional infrastructural for innovative teachings were provided 9.29% somewhat agreed and 3.7% remained neutral.

90.7% of the faculty feel that the assessment methods are in alignment with the course objectives 5.6% somewhat agreed and 3.7% remained neutral.

#### 1.3 Feedback by alumni

89.9% of our alumni rated the syllabus as excellent and 10.1% rated as good.

29% felt that there were few irrelevant parts that needs to be changed.

84.1% rated the career assistance given was excellent 14.5% rated good and 1.4% remained neutral.

79.7% rated the offering of electives in relation to healthcare advancements 20.3% rated good

82.6% rated the co-curricular activities taken up by the college to improves skills and knowledge of a subject were excellent 15.9% rated good and 1.4% remained neutral.

78.3% felt their learning experience in college is excellent and 21.7% rated good.

76.8% felt whatever learnt during student days in the institution is relevant

76.8% rated the practical knowledge of students in terms of their relevance to the real-life applications to be excellent 20.3% rated good

94.2% were wanting to be a part of guest lecture to the juniors if needed by institution.

#### 1.4 Feedback by professionals

88.5% professional said the curriculum somewhat fitted the needs of students for job placement 9.8% somewhat agreed and 1.6% remained neutral.

86.9% strongly agreed curriculum and syllabi fitted the needs of students higher education 8.2% somewhat agreed and 4.9% remained neutral.

83.6% strongly agreed that the curriculum is adequate to face real life situations 11.5% somewhat agreed to it and 4.9% remained neutral.

83.6% strongly agreed the program and curriculum is sufficient for dental health care entrepreneurship 9.8% somewhat agreed and 6.6% remained neutral.

83.6% strongly agreed theory and practical are sufficiently balanced in curriculum and syllabus 13.1% strongly agreed to it and 3.3% remained neutral

#### 1.5 Feedback by Employers

86.4% rated our student performance was excellent and 13.6% rated good

84.1% rated academic system to be satisfactory 13.6% rated good and 2.3% remained neutral


76.2% strongly agreed our students were encouraged by newer ideas and techniques and 23.8% somewhat agreed

## ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE COLLEGE FOR THE FEEDBACK AND SUGGESTIONS


- 1. Improving the availability and access to learning resources- LMS software is being procured to address this issue.
















1) How do you rate the syllabus of the course in relation to the competencies expected out of the course? 69 responses


2) Do you feel any part/parts of curriculum is irrelevant and needs modification?




3) How do you rate the assistance provided by the institute for career enhancement? 69 responses




4) How do you rate the offering of the electives in relation to the healthcare advancements? 69 responses




5) How do you rate the co-curricular activities taken up by the college to improve skills and knowledge of a subject? 69 responses




6) How was the learning experience during your student days in the institution? 69 responses




1) What is the relevance of all that you learnt during student days in the institution? 69 responses




8) How do you rate the practical knowledge of students in terms of their relevance to the real-life application? 69 responses









1. Curriculum and syllabi fitted the needs of students for Job Placements. 61 responses




2. Curriculum and syllabi fitted the needs of students Higher Education. 61 responses



3. Our curriculum is aligned to the need of real world. 61 responses






A)Name of the candidate serving in your college-44 responses




1) How satisfied are you with our student's work performance. 44 responses



2) How satisfied are you with our earlier student's academic system which educated these candidates?




